## September 2015 – UG Scholarships

### Academic Scholarships for Undergraduate Studies

**The scholarships mentioned below will be applicable for the first semester tuition fee only.**

**Note: Any discount and scholarship cannot be combined, only the highest value will be considered**

#### **CBSE (inclusive of ISC, NIOS and other Indian state board)**

- 95%+                      100% Scholarship
- 90-94.9%                50% Scholarship
- 80-89.9%                40% Scholarship
- 70-79.9%                30% Scholarship

#### **O Levels**

*Applicants may be awarded the scholarship based on provisional or predicted grades from school. Only applicants accepted based solely on their O Levels will be considered for this scheme.*

- A\* = 6 scholarship points
- A = 5 scholarship points
- B = 4 scholarship points
- C = 3 scholarship points
- D = 2 scholarship points
- E = 1 scholarship points
- F/G/U = 0 scholarship points

*Only 7 O Level subjects to be considered (top 7 grades)*

- Applicants with 35 points and above will receive a 100% Scholarship
- Applicants with 28 - 34 points will receive a 50% scholarship
- Applicants with 21 - 27 points will receive a 40% Scholarship
- Applicants with 19 - 20 points will receive a 30% scholarship

## **AS Levels**

*Applicants may be awarded the scholarship based on provisional or predicted grades from school. Only applicants accepted based on their AS Levels will be considered for this scheme. This scheme cannot be combined with the O Level Scheme.*

- A\* = 6 scholarship points
- A = 5 scholarship points
- B = 4 scholarship points
- C = 3 scholarship points
- D = 2 scholarship points
- E = 1 scholarship points
- F/G/U = 0 scholarship points

*Only 4 AS Level subjects to be considered (top 4 grades)*

- Applicants with 24 points will receive a 100% Scholarship
- Applicants with 20 - 23 points will receive a 50% scholarship
- Applicants with 16 - 19 points will receive a 40% Scholarship
- Applicants with 12 - 16 points will receive a 30% scholarship

## **A Levels**

*Applicants may be awarded the scholarship based on provisional or predicted grades from school. Only applicants accepted based on their A Levels will be considered for this scheme. This scheme cannot be combined with the O Level/AS Level Scheme.*

- A\* = 6 scholarship points
- A = 5 scholarship points
- B = 4 scholarship points
- C = 3 scholarship points
- D = 2 scholarship points
- E = 1 scholarship points
- F/G/U = 0 scholarship points

*Only 2 A Level subjects to be considered (top 2 grades)*

- Applicants with 12 points will receive a 100% Scholarship
- Applicants with 9-11 points will receive a 50% scholarship
- Applicants with 6-8 points will receive a 40% Scholarship
- Applicants with 5 points will receive a 30% scholarship

### **12 year High School (American, Local, FSC)**

- 98%+                100% Scholarship
- 95-97%             50% Scholarship
- 85-94%             40% Scholarship
- 70-84%             30% Scholarship

### **WAEC (West African Examinations Council)**

(Grade 12 - maximum of 7 subjects to be considered)

- A1=6 points,
- B2=5 points,
- B3=4 points,
- C4=3 points
- C5= 2 points
- C6= 1 point

*Only 7 subjects to be considered (top 7 grades)*

- Students scoring 35 points will receive a 50% Scholarship
- Students scoring 24 -34 points will receive a 40% Scholarship
- Student scoring 14-23 points will receive a 30% Scholarship

**Applicants from other curricula will need to apply to the scholarship committee.**

### **Scholarships after 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and subsequent Semesters**

Students who score 3.6 GPA (Excellent) or above in a Semester are eligible for 25% waiver of tuition in the next semester
